

RULES TO PLAY BY

General Information for Application for Entry

1. One form must be completed for each entry. It is critical that it be complete and legible.
2. Deadline for entries is midnight **March 29, 2018**. There will be NO exceptions. This doesn't mean that your quilt is finished but that you have made a commitment to have it done on time for the show.
3. **All quilts must have a hanging sleeve attached.** This sleeve must be a minimum of 3 inches (that is a 6 inch circumference). Temporary sleeves are acceptable. This applies to all quilts (bed, lap baby, wall hangings, etc.) as some will be strung through rods and others will be pinned.
4. Your quilt must have an identifying label on the back with minimum of your name and phone number on this label.
5. **A picture of your quilt is required.** It is not necessary that your quilt be finished before you take a picture and submit your application.
6. Please enter each quilt in ONE category only. Definitions of the categories are on the Application for Entry. If you are unsure which category is best for your entry, please contact Margaret or Frankie for help.
7. Email or fax entries will NOT be accepted. Please call if you need assistance.
8. Quilts previously shown in a PQHQG show may not be entered in this show.

GUIDELINES

9. Please fill out all areas of the Application for Entry legibly.
10. Please prioritize your entries. Space is the only determining factor as to whether or not all your quilts will be displayed.
11. We have limited space to hang queen/king bed quilts. If you have a queen/king bed quilt that you are entering, please ensure that your entries are in early. It will be a first-come-first-served basis and no more than one queen/king bed quilt from any one person will be displayed unless there is available space.
12. If your entry is on a hard backing or in a solid frame, it would be best displayed on an easel. Try to find an easel that you could use.
13. **Please fill out all areas** of the Application for Entry. Accurate measurements are essential. If your quilt is asymmetrical, the longer sides should be measured.
14. Your quilt stories are important and are appreciated by the general public as well as fellow quilters, but we ask that you keep them short (no more than 50-100 words).
15. Forms will be available at each guild meeting, on the website, and in the November newsletter. Completed forms may be dropped off at guild meetings, mailed, or hand delivered.
