

## **Celtic Knot (Pattern Provided)**

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### **Supplies for Celtic Knot:**

Fabric:

- 16” square light fabric for background (wash prior to class)
- .25 m for inner border
- .2 m for middle border
- .5 m for outer border and binding
- Coordinating fabric for insets
- Backing & batting (approx. 25” square) plus fabric for hanging sleeves

Other Supplies:

- Roll of Black Quick Bias Fusible Tape (1/4 inch minimum)
- Small iron with steam – (A travel iron works well, but the mini iron does not work as you need steam)
- A piece of fabric that can be used as a surface for ironing on. This needs to be big enough to be approximately 30” square after it has been folded. (Since so much of this project requires an iron, it is best if each participant has their own ironing surface.)
- Teflon sheet
- Plastic for making templates OR Lite Steam-A-Seam II sheet
- Scissors for cutting paper/plastic
- Pen/pencil for marking fabric inserts
- Quilter’s glue
- Quilter’s awl or stiletto

### **General Supplies:**

- Sewing machine in good working order and machine manual
- Regular sewing materials such as pins, scissors, quilting pins etc.
- Masking Tape
- Rotary cutter & Quilters’ ruler
- Thread to match continuous bias OR monofilament thread
- Walking foot for machine and quilting needle
- Thread for quilting
