

STACK 'N WHACK PINWHEEL

Supply List Approx. 50x72

Sunday, March 17, 2019 9:30 – 4:00 Bradley Centre

Main Fabric (pinwheels and borders):

You **MUST** have 8 repeats of the pattern – this means buying anywhere from 2 ½ - 5 ½ meters, depending on the length of the repeat (the remainder is used for borders and can be pieced into the back – it won't be wasted). You can choose a 12" repeat, but it is easier as well as more spectacular if the repeat is 14" or bigger. Feel free to choose **large** florals (large Kaffe and Jane Sassaman prints are excellent!), animal prints (parrots would be great), a kiddie print, a theme print (I did one with fishing boats and it was fab) -- whatever appeals to you!

** If you choose a "directional" print, make sure you purchase an additional .5 meter so that you have the option of making your borders all go one way.

Background Fabric:

Yes, you must bring this to the workshop in order to make your blocks!!

You need 2.2 meters of background fabric. In order to make this a spectacular quilt, try to choose a **contrasting** background. Look at your main fabric and try to pick out a color that is used sparingly in it – that might be the ideal choice for the background. It is not a good idea to use the background color that is in your main fabric, **unless** there is not a lot of background showing.

In addition, please bring:

- .3m contrast fabric for inner border
- .5m fabric for binding
- 6 1/2x24 ruler as well as a smaller one
- a **sharp** rotary cutter -- you are cutting through 8 layers! (the large 60mm one works best, if you have one)
- your largest cutting mat
- flower head pins, or sewing needle and thread any color
- seam ripper
- neutral thread for machine sewing
- sewing machine in good working order
- Magic Stack 'n Whack book by Bethany Reynolds

OPTIONAL: One of my samples shows sashing between the blocks. If you like this look, you will need an extra .5m of your background fabric. You will also require 1m sashing fabric and .2m or fat quarter for cornerstones, but you could choose these after your blocks are made.
